Corranto: also coranto; A dance dating from the 16th century in binary form having short "running" passages (corranto means "running"), written in a melody-accompaniment disposition. The corranto is the ancestor of the 17th century Italian corrente.

The articulations are editorial. We have added diminutions in measures 6-8 to teach you how to add them at reprises.
